National Review: Students for Life of America 'Fighting Back'

Notes how Pro-Life Group is Effectively Recruiting Next Generation of Leaders

ARLINGTON, VA - Yesterday, Dr. Michael New in National Review Online noted that Students for Life of America was effectively fighting back by recruiting and organizing new campus pro-lifers.

In an article on "The Politics of Life", Dr. New wrote about the future of effective pro-life strategies to overturn the Roe vs. Wade Supreme Court decision and simultaneously change the culture to one of life. Polls show that 63% of students enter college pro-life and 36% leave pro-life.

Students for Life of America is the only pro-life organization with a field team organizing new campus groups. Individual, paid Field Agents go out to unorganized campuses, identify leaders, and start a campus pro-life groups. Over a hundred groups were started this way last year, and the campus pro-life movement has more than doubled since August 2006 when the Students for Life of America Field Program started.

"We follow what students want: to lessen the focus on education and start doing what's effective, namely winning," SFLA Executive Director Kristan Hawkins said. "Planned Parenthood and their allies ought to be concerned, they've had a lot of success that's about to be dismantled and deconstructed by the upcoming generation who are resoundingly pro-life and ready to end abortion. These students are in college right now, it's just a matter of time."

Student President Ashley Tyndall said, "I've got no patience for the tired lies, exaggerations, and excuses from the abortion industry. There's no middle ground or compromise to be had when it comes to the slaughter of the unborn, we're simply going to work harder and longer so that Pro-Lifers win, outlaw abortion and change the culture so that abortion never returns."

Students for Life of America was founded in 1987 as American Collegians for Life. It is the only pro-life organization which focuses on organizing college students at the grassroots level. With seven full-time staff members and five field agents traveling across the country, Students for Life of America has started 147 campus pro-life groups in the past year. There are now 387 active pro-life college groups in 46 states across America.
